WAIVER, RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE

The undersigned participant ("Participant"), and Participant's parent or legal guardian ("Parent") if Participant is under the age of 18 years, have requested to attend, participate in, volunteer at, or spectate (collectively, "Participate") in the BrainSTEM Summer Camp (the "Program") and to use equipment and facilities at Ridge High School in Basking Ridge, New Jersey, including any parking lots adjacent to such building (individually and collectively, the "Facilities"). In consideration of, and as a condition to Participation in the Program, Participant and Parent hereby agree to the terms and conditions stated in this Waiver, Release from Liability and Covenant Not to Sue.

1. **Acknowledgement of Risk.** Each of Participant and Parent understands and acknowledges that the Program may include without limitation, instruction and hands-on activities with respect to robotics and engineering, the use of and exposure to Legos, scissors, sanding dust, drones, 3D printers, laser engraver and hot glue guns, and the use of other equipment associated therewith (the "Activities"). Each of Participant and Parent understands and acknowledges that serious disabilities, death, accidents, injuries and illnesses can occur during and in connection with Participating in the Program. Each of Participant and Parent further understands and acknowledges that Participating in the Activities may require the Participant, and if applicable, Parent, to perform certain activities, or to be exposed to activities, conditions, individuals, equipment or events which have potential to cause death, injury, illness, disability, or property loss. These risks and dangers may be caused by the ordinary negligence, whether active or passive, of the Participant or Parent, the ordinary negligence, whether active or passive, of other participants and/or the ordinary negligence, whether active or passive, of the persons and entities named herein as the Released Parties (as defined below). Each of Participant and Parent further understands and acknowledges that there may be risks and dangers not known to them or the Released Parties or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. Each of Parent and Participant further understands and acknowledges that neither the Program nor its facilitators provide insurance coverage for the Participant and/or Parent, as applicable. Each of Parent and Participant understands and acknowledges that Participant, and if applicable, Parent, will not be permitted to Participate in the Program without the Participant and Parent executing this Waiver, Release from Liability and Covenant Not to Sue.

2. **Assumption of Risk.** Knowing the risks inherent in, and connected with the Activities and the Program and with the full understanding of the Activities and the Program, each of Participant and Parent on behalf of himself or herself, and each of their respective executors, administrators, heirs, successors, assigns, and next of kin, HEREBY FULLY ASSUMES THE RISKS OF INJURY, ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PERSON OR PROPERTY INHERENT IN, AND/OR IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH, ATTENDING, PARTICIPATING IN, VOLUNTEERING AT, AND SPECTATING AT THE PROGRAM EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE ORDINARY NEGLIGENCE, WHETHER ACTIVE OR PASSIVE, OF ANY OF THE RELEASED PARTIES OR OTHER PERSONS EXECUTING A SIMILAR WAIVER, RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE.

3. **Release, Indemnification and Covenant Not to Sue.** PARTICIPANT AND PARENT EACH KNOWINGLY RELEASES, INDEMNIFIES, HOLDS HARMLESS, AND DISCHARGES the following persons and entities: BrainSTEM Summer Camp, and its affiliates, members, owners, managers, directors, officers, employees, agents, independent contractors, volunteers, facilitators, faculty, representatives, promoters, assigns and successors and the owners or lessees of the Facilities (the "Released Parties"), of, from, and against any claims, expenses, demands, damages, obligations, liabilities and causes of action, of any kind or nature, both in law and in equity, whether known or unknown, arising from or in connection with Participant's or Parent's Participation in the Program, whenever or however they occur and for such period the Activities may continue. PARTICIPANT AND PARENT EACH AGREE THAT NONE OF THE PARTICIPANT, PARENT, OR ANYONE ACTING ON EITHER OF THEIR BEHALF, WILL MAKE ANY CLAIM AGAINST THE RELEASED PARTIES, WHICH CLAIMS CONCERN IN ANY WAY DEATH, INJURY, ILLNESS, DAMAGE, OR LOSS OF ANY TYPE OR NATURE, WHICH ARISE OUT OF, ARE RELATED TO, OR ARE IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM OR THE ACITIVIES, AND/OR WHICH ARISE OUT OF OR ARE CONNECTED IN ANY WAY WITH THE PARTICIPANT'S OR PARENT'S USE OF, OR PRESENCE AT, THE FACILITY(IES). THIS RELEASE INCLUDES ANY LOSSES CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE ORDINARY NEGLIGENCE, WHETHER ACTIVE OR PASSIVE, OF THE RELEASED PARTIES, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND INCLUDES CLAIMS FOR INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE, WRONGFUL DEATH, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF CLAIM. Participant and Parent each agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties, from any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur (including attorneys' fees and costs), due to or in connection with Parent's or Participant's Participation in the Program and the Activities, whether caused by the ordinary negligence, whether active or passive, of the Released Parties or otherwise.

Each of Parent and Participant expressly acknowledges and agrees that this Waiver, Release from Liability and Covenant Not to Sue is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by applicable law and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

I HEREBY AFFIRM AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY AND THAT I UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I UNDERSTAND THAT I AM SURRENDERING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS AND THAT THIS DOCUMENT SHALL BE BINDING ON ME, MY MINOR CHILDREN, OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS, AND MY HEIRS, TO ACT ON MY CHILD'S BEHALF. RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS FORM

Please Read Carefully Before Signing

We/I, the undersigned, are/am the parent or guardian of a student participating in the BrainSTEM Summer Camp, a BrainSTEM Ventures LLC company.

We acknowledge that the summer camp is a positive activity which benefits our child. We also acknowledge that there are certain risks associated with our child’s participation in the camp, including the risk of personal injury or property damage, and we assume the risks of participation in the camp.

Although the summer camp is being held on the property of the Bernards Township Board of Education (“Board of Education”), we understand and acknowledge that the Board of Education does not control, sponsor or supervise the camp.

In consideration for the Board of Education permitting this positive activity to be held on its property, we hereby waive and release the Board of Education and its members, agents and employees from and against any and all liability or damage of any kind sustained by our child as a result of his or her participation in the summer camp, including, but not limited to, any claim for personal injury, disability, death, property damage or property loss.

Technology Equipment Misuse

Intentionally damaging technology equipment (vandalism) may result in the cancellation of privileges, and/or reimbursement of damages. Vandalism is defined as any malicious attempt to harm or destroy data of another user or organization, irresponsible behavior in and around computing equipment, hacking and physical damage to any network component, or as otherwise defined by law. BrainSTEM Summer Camp reserves the right to recover its expenditures. Therefore, We, the undersigned, agree to compensate BrainSTEM Summer Camp for any intentional damage to technology equipment or materials caused by the participant, whereas the damage was due to the participants carelessness or misuse through negligence.

We agree to the following behavior agreement;

A student shall not intentionally cause or attempt to cause physical or emotional injury (bullying) or intentionally behave in such a way as could reasonably cause physical/emotional injury to any person. Any student involved in fighting or promoting fighting may be subject to removal from camp without reimbursement of tuition from BrainSTEM Summer Camp.

We also agree to indemnify and hold the Board of Education and its members, agents and employees harmless from and against any and all liability or damage of any kind caused by our child in connection with his or her participation in the summer camp, including the payment of reasonable attorney’s fees associated therewith.
